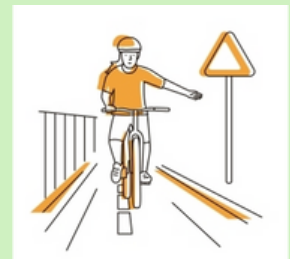
Tuesday 16th April- School Re Opens for Summer Term.

What will Your child need in order to take part?

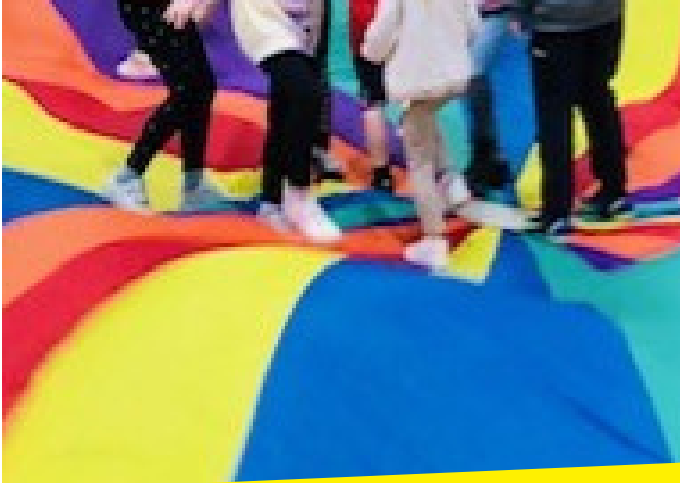
NOTE: Your child does not need to have previously completed a Level 1 course in order to take part in Level 2 training.

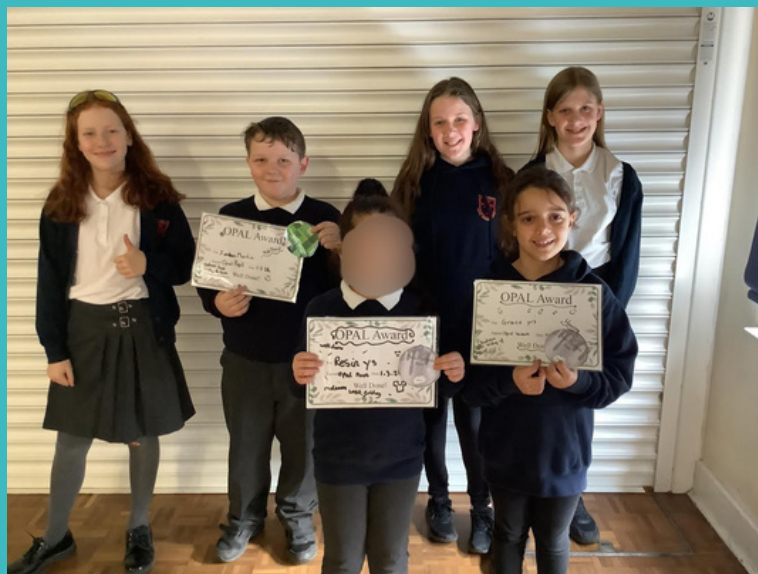
OPAL
