Year 4 have started their ECO Club.

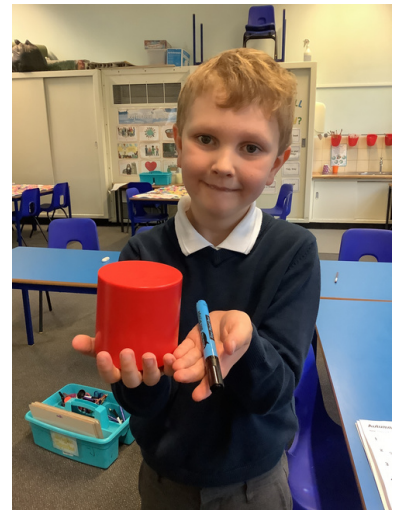
Their first task was linked to Recycling Week to create posters to encourage people to recycle.
