CATERING PROVISION FROM 1ST APRIL 2024

North Tyneside Catering Services will no longer be providing any catering services to schools from 1st April, they will cease to be our caterer at Easter and so it is important that parents do not overpay this half-term. Your last payment should be for the week commencing 25th March, but remembering that Friday 29th is Good Friday and therefore the last meal served will be Thursday 28th March.

Our new caterer will be Mellors who are a large, established company. We made this decision having looked at their offer in comparison to other providers and we believe that the quality of their food is better than that currently being served and better than that provided by other companies.

Mellors will be liaising with us about their menus and logistics over this next half-term. The key difference for parents / carers is that money will be paid directly to school.

As the school will be liable for any debts, we will not be able to allow any debts to occur as this would directly impact school budgets and children. We will explain more about this in specific catering letters. I will be sending out further communications for parents / carers around this change.


Year 4 Science - Electricity


In science, Year 4 have been completing a series of challenges to create complete circuits. There has been some amazing problem solving and lots of great communication when working together.





























North Tyneside Bikeability will soon be delivering a Bikeability Level 2 course at Christ Church for Years 5& 6.
