Year 1 Summer Term Letter

These are the areas of the curriculum we will be looking at this term.

Literacy - Our literacy work will use the books Where the Wild things are, My shadow is Pink and The Extraordinary Gardener. The pieces of writing we will do include: fact files, letters, descriptions, instructions, writing a narrative and a diary entry.

Numeracy - Place value (within 100), addition and subtraction (within 20), number facts to solve problem, counting in 2's, 5's and 10's, time, money and fractions.

We will also be continuing our Mastering Number sessions which happen four times a week for 15 minutes.

Science – Senses, seasonal changes and plants.

Topic – Coasts and Seaside's.

RE- What is a Parable? The lost Son.

Art/DT- Making collages from natural materials and design and create a Batik.

ICT- Programming.

PE- Dance and games.

Music – Songs including; Banana Rap, In the Groove and Round and Round.

PSHE - Keeping healthy, the importance of sleep, helping people, responsibilities at home and school, looking after money and basic first aid.

Spellings - Spellings will be tested on Fridays. A paper copy will be sent home each Friday.

Reading - Reading at home is also crucial to help children build on their reading skills. Children are encouraged to read the books and share a reading book for pleasure with family members. Children have a copy of their reading challenges in their books. Once they have read 15 times at home they will choose a prize.

PE kit - PE will be on Wednesdays. Please send your child into school wearing their PE kit on these days.

Forest School – This will take place on a Friday afternoon for the summer term. Can children please come in suitable outdoor clothing on these days prepared for the variety of summer weather of the UK.

In the classroom, the children will continue to be supported by Mrs Crawford.
