As a school we will:	As a parent/carer I will:	As a pupil I will:
<p>Train all staff on the safe use of PPE.</p> <p>Ensure all staff who administer first aid will wear appropriate PPE.</p> <p>Collect the children from the yard by calling them by name to join a socially distanced queue before taking them into school.</p> <p>Provide hot water, soap to wash hands.</p> <p>Place hand sanitiser around school for children to use in between hand washing.</p> <p>Directly and explicitly teach children about our expectations of accessing the school site. Children need to feel safe and supported, not regimented and frightened. They will be taught the simple rules of moving around school and accessing toilets etc.</p> <p>Continue to provide remote learning and work packs.</p> <p>Groups or 'bubbles' will have a designated member of staff. Children will not mix with other adults or children outside their group.</p> <p>Due to classroom sizes, a bubble or group will have a maximum of 8 children.</p>	<p>Contact the school via email or telephone if required. I acknowledge that the school office will not be accessible.</p> <p>Socially distance at least 2 metres at all times. I acknowledge that I may be refused entry to the site if I do not comply with this.</p> <p>Ensure outside of school, my family follows the most up to date government guidance on social distancing.</p> <p>I understand that late comers will not be allowed on site.</p> <p>Ensure your child wears school uniform, if it still fits although must be clean every day. This is to help our children to return to being on site and help them to return to our expectations of behaviour. If this is not possible then non-uniform that looks similar is acceptable.</p> <p>Accept provision offered is provisional and may change according to the way the virus develops over the coming weeks.</p> <p>Give school at least 1 weeks' notice if I want my child to begin attending school.</p> <p>Follow the government guidance if a member of my household is ill. We will notify the school immediately and follow the isolation guidance.</p>	<p>Understand that it may not be possible to be in the same group as my friends or with my teacher.</p> <p>Wash my hands frequently.</p> <p>Practise 'catch it, bin it, kill it' with tissues and wash my hands straight after.</p> <p>Wear clean clothes for school each day.</p> <p>Try to follow social distancing guidelines.</p> <p>Notify an adult immediately if I feel unwell.</p> <p>I understand that access to toilets will be managed.</p> <p>Not be able to attend school if I arrive late.</p> <p>When I am playing, I need to try and social distance from friends.</p> <p>I understand that movement around my class will be limited and I may be given a designated area to work.</p> <p>As directed by staff, follow social distancing rules when moving around school.</p> <p>I understand that teachers are not able to touch my belongings and work not completed online will be marked.</p>



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<p>Facilitate a staggered entry and exit system to and from school.</p> <p>Establish classrooms which follow government guidance by being stripped of all soft furnishings with tables and seating socially distanced by 2metres.</p> <p>Provide children with their own stationery and pencil case.</p> <p>Ensure all shared resources are cleaned after use.</p> <p>Deep clean after each group to ensure no cross contamination.</p> <p>Provide daily packed lunches for children in Reception and KS1 and those in receipt of free school meals in Ks2.</p>	<p>Understand that as a school we will aim to keep children socially distanced, but I understand that this may not always be possible, especially with younger children.</p> <p>Ensure that my child does not bring anything to school from home apart from a water bottle and packed lunch if required.</p>
